After a period of change and transition for all of us due to new laws, new procedures and new staff, we feel like we have settled into a comfortable rhythm. Here are some reminders about upcoming events/necessary housekeeping items:

- The next CASA Training Class will be starting soon so if you know of someone who is interested, please have them contact the office and we will be happy to send them an application packet. Orientation is planned for February 9th so time is of the essence!
- Don't forget that part of your training includes 12 hours of in-service training throughout the year. We offer Peer Groups monthly (2nd Tuesday of each month from 11:30a.m.-1:00p.m.) in addition to webinars throughout the year. The next Peer Group meeting will be here at the CASA office on Tuesday, February 9th so mark your calendars.
- Monthly Reports are due in to your Advocate Coordinator by the end of each month and are very important to us for many reasons. Without these monthly updates, we are in the dark about where your case stands. They are also very important in that a great deal of our grant funding comes from the time and mileage you record when working on your cases.
- If you have not signed a 2016 VOCA contract, please stop by the office and do so the next time you are in the area. This is vital to continuing the grant funding we receive.
- We have several children who are placed outside of Glynn County who are in need of CASA's. Please let us know if you are interested in filling that need.
